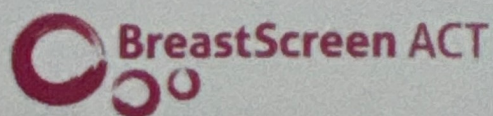
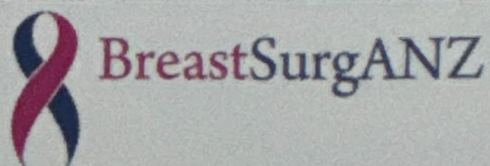

MY PROFESSIONAL SYNOPSIS:

I am a Breast, Endocrine, Laparoscopic and General Surgeon with more than 10 years of surgical experience, and I have been based in Canberra for over 7 years. I believe in a holistic and individualised approach, tailoring treatment to each patient's needs.

My practice includes both private and public patients.

Hospital procedures: I perform operations that require a general anaesthetic in a hospital.

Day procedures under local anaesthetic: Many conditions can be safely treated in my clinic without the need for hospital admission. These include skin cancers, cysts, lipomas, keloids, ingrown toenails, vasectomies, circumcisions, carpal tunnel release, ganglion excisions, and removal of accessory breast tissue.

As a Breast and Endocrine subspecialist, I treat breast cancer with a wide range of surgical techniques, including breast-conserving surgery, reconstruction, and reduction procedures. I also perform thyroid, parathyroid, and adrenal surgery.

As a General and Laparoscopic Surgeon, I perform hernia repairs (both open and keyhole), abdominal wall reconstructions, and haemorrhoid surgery including HAL-RAR.

I am actively involved in multidisciplinary team meetings for breast, skin, sarcoma, and thyroid cancers at Canberra Hospital. I place a strong emphasis on evidence-based practice and I am committed to teaching and mentoring junior doctors.

PROCEDURES PERFORMED

BREAST SURGERY:

- Breast cancer surgery: Mastectomy – simple and skin/nipple sparing with implant reconstruction or Wide Local excision of breast cancer (breast conservation surgery) with axillary surgery
- Breast reduction – for symptomatic macromastia, therapeutic (as a part of breast cancer surgery in patients with macromastia), and symmetrisation (to match the normal breast with cancer affected breast).
- Benign breast lump surgery (Fibroadenomas, mammographic abnormalities) – I perform these procedures with oncoplastic techniques
- Inverted nipple correction and surgery for accessory breast tissue in axilla
- Surgery for Gynaecomastia & male breast cancer

ENDOCRINE SURGERY:

- Total thyroidectomy and hemithyroidectomy
- Parathyroidectomy including minimally invasive surgery
- Full assessment & work up for Adrenal lesions and laparoscopic adrenalectomy

SKIN CANCERS, SARCOMA & LUMPS/BUMPS:

- Management of all types of skin cancers, suspicious moles, skin tags and warts (selected cases can be excised in the office)
- Melanoma surgery
- Soft tissue Sarcoma
- Lipomas, cysts and other lumps and bumps
- Ingrown nail surgery
- Ganglion surgery

SALIVARY GLAND SURGERY:

Parotid and Submandibular glands' surgery for cancer, benign tumours, and stone-related inflammation (sialadenitis)

PROCEDURES PERFORMED

SURGERY FOR COMMON ANAL CONDITIONS:

- Haemorrhoidectomy (open and stapled), rubber band ligation and HAL RAR (Haemorrhoidal Artery Ligation + RectoAnal Repair)
- Anal fissures – nonsurgical and surgical management (Botox and Lateral internal anal sphincterotomy)
- Surgery for anal fistulas (Seton placement, laying open & FIPS – Fistulotomy with Immediate Primary Sphincteroplasty)
- Perianal abscess – drainage
- Pilonidal Sinus surgery (for recurrent / complex Pilonidal disease requiring flap surgery)

COLON SURGERY (CANCER & BENIGN):

- Open and laparoscopic bowel surgery
- Laparoscopic adhesiolysis
- Laparoscopic stoma formation

COMMON SURGICAL CONDITIONS:

- Gall bladder surgery for gallstones
- Adult Inguinal, Femoral, Umbilical, Epigastric and all other hernias – performed with both open and Laparoscopic surgery
- Ventral hernia repair and Incisional/recurrent hernia repair (open & laparoscopic)
- Hydrocele surgery
- Male circumcision – “in-office” with single used TGA approved stapler under local anaesthetic (LA) from birth till age 6 months & then from age 9 ys onwards. For adults, circumcision is done either with “V Flap” or stapler under LA.
- Vasectomy including “No Scalpel” technique
- Carpal tunnel release surgery – under both LA (selected cases) and GA
- Abdominoplasty (tummy tuck) as an adjunct to abdominal wall hernia or split muscles (divarication of recti).
